Excellency,

I am writing to categorically and unequivocally reject the baseless and fabricated allegations leveled against the Islamic Republic of Iran in the letters dated 29 May and 24 June 2025 from the representative of the Israeli regime addressed to the Secretary General and President of the Security Council (S/2025/337- S/2025/416).

These unfounded claims are nothing more than a deliberate attempt to deflect attention from and provide an excuse for the Israeli regime's ongoing and systematic violations of international law, Security Council Resolution 1701(2006), including its continued occupation of Lebanese territory and repeated acts of aggression against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Lebanon. Iran has always respected the national sovereignty, independence, and territorial integrity of Lebanon, has complied with Security Council Resolution 1701, and has never engaged in any activity inconsistent with its provisions.


For years, the Israeli occupying regime has persistently and egregiously violated Security Council Resolution 1701 (2006), by maintaining its illegal military presence on Lebanese territory, occupying part of Lebanese territories, conducting near-daily incursions into Lebanese airspace and territory, and undermining the ceasefire agreement. These actions constitute grave breaches of the UN Charter, international law, and Security Council Resolution 1701.

The Security Council must not remain silent in the face of these flagrant and persistent violations. It must uphold its Charter-mandated responsibility to maintain international peace and security by taking urgent and concrete measures to end the occupying regime's unlawful acts, including its ongoing violations of Resolution 1701 (2006), and to ensure full accountability for its internationally wrongful acts.
