Dear Coordinator,

I am writing to you in your capacity as the Coordinator of the Panel of Experts on Yemen, as set out pursuant to Security Council resolution 2758 (2024), and with reference to your letters S/AC.56/2025/PE/OC.027, dated 25 June 2025, and S/AC.56/2025/PE/OC.065 dated 24 July 2025, and while transmitting herewith an attachment containing the responses pertaining to certain topics raised in the aforementioned letters, I wish to draw your kind attention to the following:


The Islamic Republic of Iran, as a responsible founding member of the United Nations, remains committed to the Charter of the United Nations and its very purposes and principles, including respect for the sovereignty and territorial integrity of States. Despite its continued reservations and legitimate concerns regarding resolutions 2216 and 2140, Iran has consistently demonstrated its commitment with respect to these resolutions. Over the past several years, Iran has constructively engaged with the Panel of Experts, clarified its position, and, among others, hosted the Panel delegation in 2019, all of which demonstrate clear evidence of this commitment.

Notwithstanding, I would like to express our continued serious concerns as to the politicization of the works of the Panel and unsubstantiated allegations thereof. As the exacerbation of the present situation in Yemen evinces, reports on the basis of illegitimate political objectives of certain States would only serve as a tool to justify unlawful policies, including acts of aggression and military intervention, in violation of the UN Charter. Such politicization also derails the mandate that the Panel has been entrusted with and prevents it from fulfilling its objectives. These unacceptable approaches continue to undermine prospects for continued cooperation of States. This is a formidable challenge that needs to be addressed appropriately.



In light of the foregoing, while reiterating the previous positions of the Islamic Republic of Iran delineated in our previous communications, I would like to convey my strong expectation that the Panel carry out its mandate in an impartial and objective manner, refrain from politicization of its work, and exercise diligence to prevent abuse of its reports for unjust political purposes.
