Excellency,

I am writing to firmly and unequivocally reject the false and baseless allegations against the Islamic Republic of Iran in the letter dated 6 October 2025 from the representative of the Israeli regime addressed to the Secretary General and President of the Security Council (S/2025/621). These fabricated claims are nothing more than a cynical attempt by Israel to justify its ongoing acts of aggression and systematic violations of Lebanon's sovereignty, territorial integrity, and the principles of international law and the Charter of the United Nations. Furthermore, Israel, through deliberate disinformation and fabricated accusations, is attempting to incite internal conflict inside Lebanon and create a pretext for another military aggression against Lebanon.

The Security Council must not remain silent in the face of these flagrant and persistent violations. It must uphold its Charter-mandated responsibility to maintain international peace and security by taking urgent and concrete measures to end the occupying regime's unlawful acts, including its ongoing violations of Resolution 1701 (2006), and to ensure full accountability for its internationally wrongful acts.

The Islamic Republic of Iran's policy toward Lebanon is grounded in full respect for international law and the purposes and principles of the United Nations Charter, including the sovereign equality of States, non-intervention in the internal affairs of other countries, and respect for Lebanon's sovereignty, unity, and territorial integrity.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as an official document of the Security Council.
