Excellency,

Upon instructions from my Government, and with reference to my previous letters, including those dated 3, 7, 16, 18, 26, 30, and 31 March 2026, I wish to inform you and the members of the Security Council of the following:

Based on continuing monitoring and assessments conducted by the Armed Forces of the Islamic Republic of Iran, it has been ascertained that the aggressor, namely the United States, has continued to use the territory and airspace of the Kingdom of Bahrain for the planning, preparation, equipping, and execution of unlawful military attacks against the Islamic Republic of Iran. Some specific instances are as follows:

- At 12:50 hours on 23 March 2026, a United States F-16SV fighter jet, by utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the State of Bahrain, carried out the bombing of targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;
- At 21:56 hours on 23 March 2026, United States B-1 bomber aircraft, by utilising and transiting the airspace of the State of Bahrain, carried out the bombing of targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran; and
- At 10:50 hours on 3 April 2026, a United States P-8A reconnaissance aircraft, operating over the airspace of the Kingdom of Bahrain, provided intelligence support to United States fighter aircraft.

In view of the international responsibility of States arising from placing their territory at the disposal of others for the commission of acts of aggression and the conduct of armed attacks against the territory of a third State, the Islamic Republic of Iran expresses its strong and unequivocal objection to the aforementioned unlawful actions and strictly calls upon the Kingdom of Bahrain to observe the principles of good neighbourliness and to prevent the continued use of its territory against the Islamic Republic of Iran.



The Government of the Kingdom of Bahrain bears full responsibility for the consequences of these egregious violations.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as an official document of the Security Council.
