Communiqué of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Islamic Republic of Iran Rejecting the Unfounded Allegations by the United Arab Emirates

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Islamic Republic of Iran, while condemning the destabilizing actions of the authorities in Abu Dhabi in collusion with hostile parties against the Islamic Republic of Iran—including the continued hosting of their military bases and equipment—warns of the dangerous consequences of such conduct for regional peace and stability.

Over the past two days, concurrent with the escalation of unlawful and provocative actions by United States military forces in the region, as well as their maritime activities conducted under the deceptive guise of humanitarian operations, officials in Abu Dhabi have, in a manner contrary to the principle of good-neighbourliness and in violation of the fundamental principles of the Charter of the United Nations, engaged in evident cooperation with the aggressor; the United States, thereby threatening the national security and interests of Iran. Nevertheless, the Islamic Republic of Iran has exercised maximum restraint, acting responsibly and with due regard for the collective interests of the region and the Islamic Ummah.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs, while rejecting the unfounded allegations by Abu Dhabi that Iran has launched missiles and drones toward the United Arab Emirates, emphasizes that the defensive actions of the Armed Forces of the Islamic Republic of Iran at this stage have been exclusively directed at countering hostile acts by the United States.

Reaffirming the Islamic Republic of Iran's commitment to the principles of the Charter of the United Nations, the fundamental rules of international law, and the principle of good-neighbourliness in its relations with all countries of the region, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs strongly calls upon Abu Dhabi to refrain from continued collusion and participation with hostile parties—the United States and the Israeli regime—in acts contrary to international law against Iran.

The Islamic Republic of Iran will not hesitate to take all necessary and appropriate measures to safeguard its national interests and security.
