Communiqué of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Islamic Republic of Iran on the United States' Acts of Aggression, in flagrant violation of Article 2 (4) of the Charter of the United Nations, and the Material Breach of the Islamabad Memorandum of Understanding

Tehran, Iran- 8 July 2026

In the early hours of Wednesday, 8 July 2026, the United States carried out military attacks against several monitoring and surveillance facilities located along the southern coast of the Islamic Republic of Iran, in flagrant violation of Article 2, paragraph 4, of the Charter of the United Nations. These acts of aggression also constitute a material breach of paragraph 1 of the Memorandum of Understanding on the ending of the US war of aggression, which provides for the cessation of all US military actions.

The repetition of these unlawful attacks against the Islamic Republic of Iran, together with the decision taken by the United States Department of the Treasury to revoke the license for the sale of Iranian oil—an obligation expressly undertaken by the United States under paragraph 10 of the Memorandum of Understanding—the violation of the arrangements concerning the Strait of Hormuz, and the continued military aggression and terrorist acts perpetrated by the Israeli regime against Lebanon, have rendered essential and fundamental elements of the Memorandum of Understanding ineffective. The United States, through the repeated breaches of its commitments, bears full responsibility for the dangerous consequences arising from this escalation.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs further recalls the international legal obligation incumbent upon all States, particularly the neighbouring States situated along the southern coast of the Persian Gulf, to prevent their territory, airspace, and facilities from being used by the aggressors for the purpose of carrying out acts of aggression against the Islamic Republic of Iran. It emphasizes that any form of assistance or cooperation facilitating the commission of the crime of aggression against Iran constitutes complicity in, and participation in, that internationally wrongful act.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs strongly condemns the United States' repeated acts of aggression and persistent violations of its commitments. Recalling the responsibilities of the United Nations Security Council and the Secretary-General under the Charter of the United Nations for the maintenance of international peace and security, the Ministry reaffirms that the powerful Armed Forces of the Islamic Republic of Iran, as repeatedly demonstrated, will not hesitate to exercise Iran's inherent right of self-defence, in accordance with Article 51 of the Charter of the United Nations, to defend its sovereignty, territorial integrity and national security against any military aggression by the United States, and will also target the source and origin of such aggression.
